HOPE Harmonious Rockers – Student Band Team

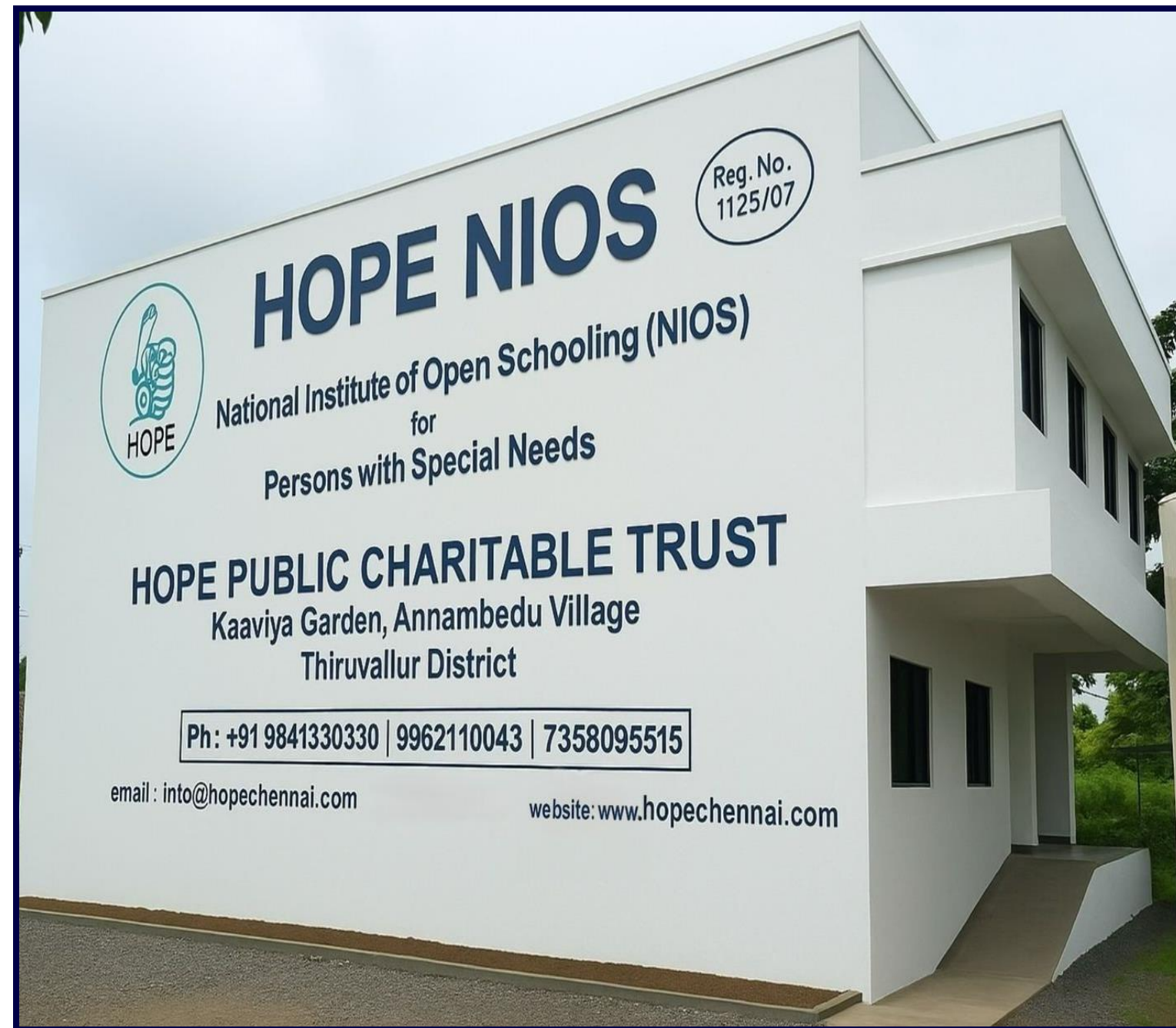
- A unique band team formed by children with special needs
